



“Prairie Schooner Visiting Norfolk”



Two editors from “Prairie Schooner”, a quarterly literary journal associated with the University of Nebraska at Lincoln, will be coming to the Norfolk Public Library December 17 at 7:00 pm.

Kwame Dawes, editor-in-chief of the internationally acclaimed journal, will be accompanied by poet and managing editor, Marianne Kunkel, on a visit to

libraries in 12 cities in Nebraska during the month of December.

Each visit will feature poetry readings by Dawes and Kunkel followed by a question and answer session. Kunkel will describe what goes into producing the journal and offer information about submissions. Single copies and subscriptions to the journal will also be available at that time.

According to the journal’s website the “Prairie Schooner” is “a national literary quarterly published with the support of the English Department at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln and the University of Nebraska Press, (and) is home to the best fiction, poetry, essays, and reviews being published today by beginning, mid-career, and established writers.”
