

Invitation For Bids

Sealed bids for the construction of Northeast Industrial Elevated Water Tank and Booster Station Improvements, Norfolk, NE – 2019 will be received by the City of Norfolk, at the City office at 309 N. 5th Street, Norfolk, NE, until 2:00 pm local time on Thursday, October 10, 2019, at which time the Bids received will be publicly opened and read.

The project consists of constructing:

Bid Section "A" – Construction of a 750,000 gallon elevated water storage tank including all foundation design, water storage tank design, fabrication, construction, cranes, permits, mobilization, staging, erection, welding, piping, fittings, painting, sterilization, pre-filling, leakage testing, settlement monitoring, telemetry, coordination, and all other associated work as indicated on the drawings and within the specifications to furnish and construct a complete and functioning elevated water storage tank.

Alternate Bid Section "A" – Construction of the 750,000 gallon elevated water storage tank with steel meeting the requirements of the American Iron and Steel (AIS) provision as defined by America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018.

Bid Section "B" - Construction of improvements at the northeast booster station including the installation of a 100 Hp booster pump, bypass line, valves, piping, fittings, electrical, painting, and all other associated work as indicated on the drawings and within the specifications.

Bids shall be on a Unit Price basis.

A pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 p.m. local time on September 26, 2019 at the training room at the City offices at 309 N. 5th Street Norfolk, NE. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged, but is not mandatory.

Bid security shall be furnished in accordance with the Instruction to Bidders. The check(s) or bond(s) shall be made payable to City of Norfolk, 309 N. 5th Street, Norfolk NE, 68701, as security that the bidder(s) to whom the award(s) are made will enter into contract to build the improvements bid upon and furnish the required bonds and insurance. Each successful bidder shall supply a Performance Bond and a Payment Bond executed by a corporate surety licensed in the State of Nebraska in an amount equal to 100 percent of the contract price as part of his contract.

The City of Norfolk reserves the right to accept any bid which it deems most advantageous to the City, and to reject any or all bids submitted and to hold as many bids as it desires for consideration for a period of sixty (60) days after the bids are open.
